Why Public Health Reporting



Provides the means to collect data on real world patient outcomes



Creates a feedback mechanism for health care providers—how well are patients faring under treatment?



Facilitate changes in care, and improvements in outcomes, based on that feedback.

Stage 3 Objective 8

Objective: The EP is in active engagement with a public health agency or clinical data registry to submit electronic public health data in a meaningful way using certified EHR technology, except where prohibited, and in accordance with applicable law and practice.

Measures: The public health reporting objective for EPs includes five measures. In Stage 3, EPs must attest to any combination of two measures.

Active engagement - the provider is in the process of moving towards sending "production data" to a public health agency or clinical data registry or is sending production data to a public health agency or clinical data registry.

Active Engagement – Option 1

Completed Registration to Submit Data:

- Registered to submit data with the PHA or CDR
- Registration was completed within 60 days after the start of the EHR reporting period; and the EP is awaiting an invitation from the PHA or CDR to begin testing and validation
- EPs who have registered in previous years do not need to submit an additional registration to meet this requirement for each EHR reporting period.



Active Engagement – Option 2

Testing and Validation:

- EP is in the process of testing and validation of the electronic submission of data
- Providers must respond to requests from the PHA or CDR within 30 days
- Failure to respond twice within an EHR reporting period would result in that provider not meeting the measure.



Active Engagement – Option 3

Production:

- Testing and validation of the electronic submission of data is complete
- Electronically submitting data to production system

Measure 1 – Provider must be sending and receiving immunization electronically



Exclusion – Does not administer any immunizations

I-CARE Illinois Comprehensive Automated Immunization Registry Exchange

Measure 2 – Syndromic Surveillance

IDPH is not currently accepting syndromic surveillance data from Eligible Providers.

IDPH is only accepting accepting syndromic surveillance data EH, CAH and Urgent Care Centers

IDPH will accept HL7 standard, electronic Initial Case Reports (eICR) from Eligible Providers.

IDPH will accept certified electronic case reports that follow the 2015 edition test methods.

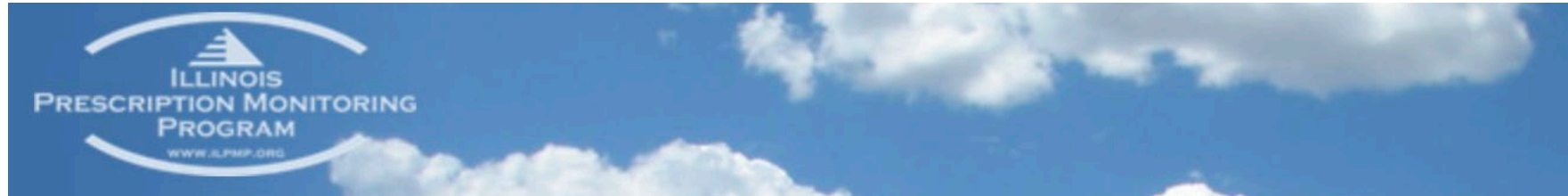

DOES NOT DIAGNOSE OR DIRECTLY TREAT THEIR JURISDICTION'S REPORTABLE DISEASE SYSTEM OR DOES NOT DIAGNOSE OR DIRECTLY TREAT ANY DISEASE OR CONDITION ASSOCIATED WITH PUBLIC HEALTH REGISTRY OR CLINICAL DATA REGISTRY IN THEIR JURISDICTION DURING THE EHR REPORTING PERIOD



OPERATES IN A JURISDICTION FOR WHICH NO PUBLIC HEALTH AGENCY IS CAPABLE OF RECEIVING ELECTRONIC CASE REPORTING DATA IN THE SPECIFIC STANDARDS REQUIRED TO MEET THE CEHRT DEFINITION AT THE START OF THE EHR REPORTING PERIOD



OPERATES IN A JURISDICTION WHERE NO PUBLIC HEALTH AGENCY HAS DECLARED READINESS TO RECEIVE ELECTRONIC CASE REPORTING DATA AS OF 6 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE START OF THE EHR REPORTING PERIOD.
